**The Administrative State** – The administrative state is in flux. Join us for an engaging discussion about new developments in the laws and policies of federal agencies, with a focus on how these changes may affect the Federal Circuit's varied areas of jurisdiction. Panelists will discuss judicial review of agency decisions following Loper Bright and SEC v. Jarkesy, as well as the changing approach of the executive branch to the administrative state. Panelists will cover developments at the U.S. International Trade Commission, such as the Lashify decision addressing domestic industry and the potential fate of Suprema's rule conferring ITC jurisdiction over alleged post-importation infringement. Panelists also will discuss developments at the U.S. Patent and Trademark Office, including policy changes affecting the Patent Trial and Appeal Board and its Administrative Patent Judges, as well as the agency's engagement with emerging issues such as artificial intelligence and evolving matters, including patent term adjustment. Panelists also will share insights on administrative law developments in the areas of government contracting, customs, and tariffs, as relevant to the U.S. Court of Federal Claims and the U.S. Court of International Trade. Our expert panelists will explore these vital issues and their potential ramifications for the future of administrative law at the Federal Circuit and beyond.
