

Anantara The Marker Hotel overlooks the waterfront on Grand Canal Square in the heart of Dublin Docklands. The Dublin Docklands are now known as Silicon Docks and host the European headquarters of Google, Facebook, and LinkedIn.

The canal on which the Anantara The Marker Hotel is located is 82 miles long and was once lined with cast iron "markers" that signified the distance along the canal. The hotel's name, "The Marker," reflects this history, as it is located where the final marker was situated.



The 2026 Global Series will close with a Friday evening reception at the **Guinness Storehouse** from 7:30 to 11:30 pm located in the historic Liberties area of Dublin, at St James's Gate. The reception is included with registration and transportation from the Anantara will be provided.

Guinness celebrated its 250th anniversary in 2009. The Storehouse was built between 1902 and 1904 and was used as a fermentation house. Still visible today in the Storehouse are pipes, machinery, and huge vats preserved from those times. Attendees will have the opportunity to explore at their leisure.
